(This is an MST required Class)

Driving Instructions: 6987 Perimeter Rd. S. Seattle (Boeing Field)  
I-5 southbound:

1. Take exit 161, Swift/Albro, and turn right onto Albro
2. Turn left at the first street that goes left (S. Hardy) then left again at the next corner.
3. At light, make a right onto Airport Way S.
4. Proceed south to the North Entrance to King County Airport. Turn right onto Perimeter Road and look for the Airlift Northwest sign. (This is north of the Terminal Bldg and the King Co EOC) Park in parking lot.

I-5 northbound:

1. Take exit 158, Airport Way / E. Marginal Way, bear right onto cloverleaf and continue over I-5 westbound (Boeing Access Rd). Just past the stoplight at the exit, get in the far right lane.
2. Take the exit onto Airport Way S.
3. Follow Airport Way S, north, past the Terminal Building, to the North Entrance to King Co Airport. Turn left onto Perimeter Rd.. Look for the Airlift Northwest sign. Park in parking lot.
