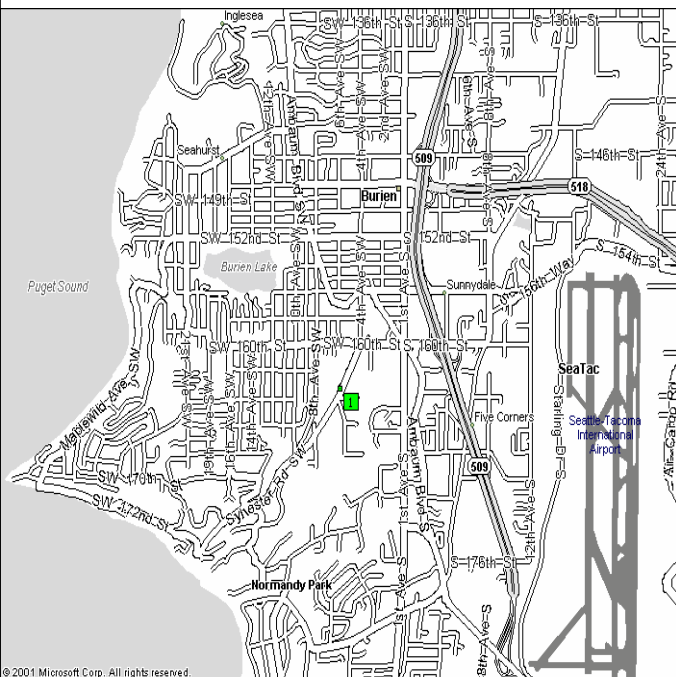
MEDICAL SERVICES Communications Team TRAINING PROGRAM

Driving Instructions:

- From I-5, take the Burien/SeaTac Airport Exit onto Highway 518.
- As freeway ends, watch for signs to 509 South/Des Moines. Turn left onto 509.
- Take first exit, South 160th Street. Turn right onto 160th. Cross First Avenue south (second traffic signal) through flashing light to Sylvester Road SW (third traffic signal).
- Turn left onto Sylvester (middle school on left). Hospital is on right.
- Turn right into driveway and parking is available in the parking garage on the left.
- Enter the Main entrance of the hospital across the driveway from the parking garage.
- When you enter the lobby, the Alder Wing is to the right. Go to the back of the lobby and down a short hallway to the right. Halfway down the short hallway is another short hallway to the left. The doorway to the auditorium/conference room 1 is at the end of that second short hallway.
